

Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 pink eraser
- 1 large white glue bottle
- 1 small box of washable markers "Original" colours – wide tipped
- 1 box of crayons – 24 pack is sufficient
- 2 **primary** pencils (with eraser on the end)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 20 page **coil-bound** scrapbook
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 pair of scissors – left or right handed as required) please make sure your child is able to cut with them)
- 2 duo-tangs (1 blue and 1 red)
- 1 duo-tang with pocket (any color)
- 1 paint shirt
- 1 pair of runners – to be left at school – please purchase runners that your child is able to put on independently (laces or Velcro)
- 1 school bag to be used daily – please purchase a school bag that is easy for your child to open and close and is large enough for his/her needs
- 1 recipe of Play Dough (below) – stored in a small container (margarine tub)
- 1 small exercise book – ½ plain and ½ interlined
- 1 large Ziploc bag with your child's name on it
- 1 pencil case or sturdy box – please put markers, crayons, scissors, 1 glue stick and 1 pencil in the box. All of the extra supplies can be put in the Ziploc bag.

Play Dough Recipe

1 cup flour	1 cup water
5 tsp. cream of tartar	2 tsp. food colouring
¼ cup salt	1 tbsp. vegetable oil

- Mix flour, cream of tartar and salt together in a saucepan.
- Combine water, food colouring and oil. Add to dry ingredients and stir until well mixed.
- Cook over medium heat stirring constantly (3-5 minutes) until the mixture forms a dry ball in the centre of the saucepan.
- Turn out and cool until easy to handle. Knead until smooth.
- Store in airtight container.

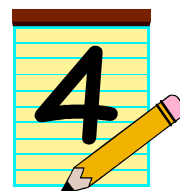

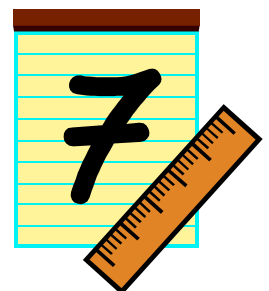
